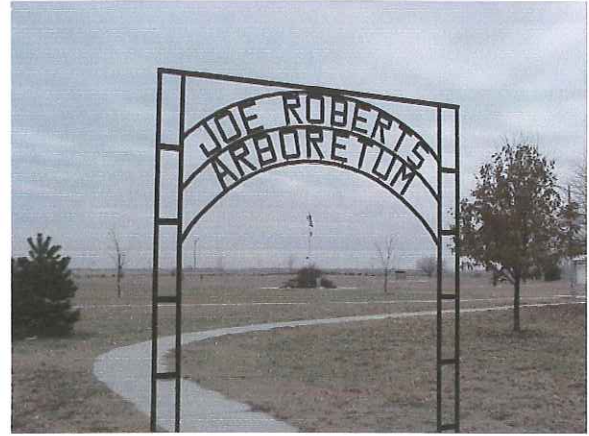


VALLEY MEMORIAL TREES



The Valley Memorial Trees program was developed to foster and perpetuate the planting of trees by any citizen of Valley in memory of a friend or loved one.

You may select the variety of tree you wish to plant from a list provided at Valley City Hall. If you choose to purchase your tree from Lanoha Nursery and inform them it is for the City of Valley Memorial Program you will receive a 15% discount.

Rules governing the planting of trees:

The size of trees:

1. Shade trees must be one and a half inch caliber or larger.
2. Ornamental trees must be one inch caliber or larger.
3. Evergreen trees must be 3 to 5 feet tall.

Planting Instructions:

1. City personnel will select the appropriate site, please allow three days notice.
2. Donor may plant tree under supervision of City personnel or City personnel will plant tree if requested.
3. City will water, mulch and place numbered marker to identify memorial.
4. If for any reason the tree does not survive, the City will not be held liable.
5. Donors are encouraged to come and visit their Memorial Tree in the Arboretum at any time.



You may enter the Arboretum from the east end of Condron St. Your Memorial Tree and its location will be listed on the message board at that location. If you would like further information please contact Valley City Hall at 359-2251.
